
**AMENDMENT TO FEBRUARY 5, 2014  
PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY  
February 14, 2014**

*WHEREAS, on February 5, 2014, I proclaimed the existence of a disaster emergency across the commonwealth due to severe winter weather; and*

*WHEREAS, various state agencies and departments continue to incur disaster related expenses resulting from the severe winter weather conditions.*

*NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Subsection §7301(c) of the Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa. C.S. Section §7101 et seq.,) I do hereby amend my proclamation of February 5, 2014 as follows:*

*I hereby transfer an additional amount of up to \$500,000 in unused appropriated funds, which amount may be increased or decreased as conditions require, to the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency for disaster related expenses incurred by various state agencies and departments. These funds shall be credited to the special account established by the Office of the Budget.*
