### CLOSED:

**ROAD CLOSURE – Lebanon County, 4/7/16** - An accident involving two tractor trailers at mile marker 93 in Swatara Township, closed I-81 northbound between Exit 90 and Exit 100 for three hours. One of the trucks was a tandem carrying 1,400 pounds of Bic butane lighters and was overturned. A traffic detour was established. There was a diesel fuel spill from a damaged saddle tank.

**SCHOOL BOMB THREAT – Berks County, 4/7/16** - The discovery of written bomb threat at Muhlenberg Middle School located at 801 E. Bellevue Avenue in Laureldale Borough prompted the evacuation of the school. A subject was taken into custody for making the false threats.

**APARTMENT FIRE – Allegheny County 4/7/16** - A fire occurred on the 6<sup>th</sup> floor of the Springdale Highrise Apartments located on Pittsburgh Street in Springdale Borough. The eight story, 90 unit building is owned by the Allegheny Housing Authority. Approximately 50 residents were displaced due to the fire.

### 24-hour Projected Weather Statewide:

#### National Weather Service, 0557 hours, 04/8/16:

Expect cloudy skies through late this morning with frequent snow showers over the northwest mountains and Laurel Highlands and scattered snow and rain showers across the south-central mountains and Susquehanna Valley region.

Skies will become partly to mostly sunny for the afternoon across much of central and eastern Pennsylvania while clouds linger across the western mountains. Gusty west to west-northwest winds will occur today. Peak gusts will be around 30 mph this afternoon. High temperatures today will be below normal ranging from the upper 30s across the northwest mountains to the low 50s across the Southeastern Piedmont. Temperatures early Saturday morning will dip into the lower to mid 20s across the northern and western mountains and settle out in the upper 20s throughout the Susquehanna Valley.


Accumulating late-season snow will spread east across the state late tonight through midday Saturday as a potent upper air disturbance drops southeast from the western Great Lakes. Northwest wind gusts of 35-40 mph will be likely late Saturday morning and afternoon as low pressure intensifies just off the mid Atlantic coast.

Improving conditions should arrive for Sunday followed by moderating temperatures and increasing rain chances into early next week.
