POTENTIAL LANDSLIDE – Blair County, 04/13/16 - The Department of Environmental Protection Headquarters is working on an Emergency Permit request to repair a storm water channel at Logan Town Center strip mall located at 150 Falon Lane in Logan Township. A crack in the slope behind the mall has grown from less than inch to over a foot in two days. The concern was that the rock wall could slide into the shops. Jersey barriers have been positioned as a safety measure to help block a slide. The owner and tenants of the mall have all been notified.


A sprawling high pressure centered in southeastern Canada will maintain fair and dry weather in Pennsylvania for the next several days.
