**BOILER FAILURE – Clarion County, 4/21/16** - The boiler system has failed at the Clarion County Prison located at 217 Amsler Avenue in Shippenville Borough. The prison has requested use of PEMA's portable shower trailer – request has been granted.

**BRUSH FIRE – Monroe County, 4/20/16** - Two large wildfires are underway in the area of Barrett Township and northern Price Township. The larger fire consists of approximately 10 miles of open fire with 1000 plus acres involved. The second fire is 400 plus acres. There are eight county fire companies along with DCNR/Bureau of Forestry involved in firefighting operations. Neither fire is contained at this time. As of 4/21/16, DCNR advised there are three air tankers (463, 875 and 855) involved in water drops along with 2 helo tankers. DCNR is requesting cots and quarters for 30 firefighters. County 911 notified county EMA for the the resource.

**BRUSH FIRE – Fayette County, 4/18/16** - A 300 acres wildfire was reported in the area of 1111 Wirsing School Road in Wharton Township. DCNR and several local fire departments were on location. No structures were reported to be threatened. Two firefighters were transported to local hospitals for heat exhaustion. A heli tanker and two air tankers are assisting. As of 4/21/16, 30% of the fire was contained and DCNR is sending a Type III team to manage the fire.

**PUBLIC SAFETY PHONE ISSUES – Indiana County, 4/15/16** – The Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP) has been experiencing a phone outage since 4/14/16 that is impacting some facilities on the main campus, Punxsutawney and the North Pointe campuses. Impacted facilities include the Department of Public Safety. They identified a cut phone line at a nearby construction site. As of 4/21/16, IUP's IT was able to place a temporary patch on phone lines and there has been partial restoration. The alarm systems are working on the temporary patch at the main and branch campuses. IUP Public Safety continues to monitor the situation. Verizon technicians continue working on repairing the cut telephone line.

#### **CLOSED:**

**CIVIL DISORDER – Dauphin County, 4/21/16** – Capital Police requested assistance at the Farm Show Complex for fights breaking out at the Donald Trump Rally. EMS treated an assault victim on scene. Six arrests were made.

**MISSING PERSON - Franklin County, 4/20/16** - The PA State Police and local units searched for an 11 year old female in Lurgan Township. The missing female was located in the morning of 4/21/16 and was safe.

**BRUSH FIRE – Centre County, 4/19/16** - A large wildfire was reported in the area of 187 Spike Island Road in Rush Township. DCNR, local fire departments and air tanker 837 responded. No structures were threatened. All local fire units are clear.


A cold front approaching Pennsylvania will bring mainly cloudy and showery weather to the state today with highs in the 60s and 70s. The showers will taper off from northwest to southeast tonight, with a few showers potentially lingering across the southeast counties into Saturday morning.

High pressure will build into the region from the Great Lakes this weekend bringing clearing skies Saturday and mostly sunny weather is anticipated for Sunday.

Highs will be mostly in the the 60s this weekend. Lows tonight should be mainly in the 40s and 50s. Saturday night will be quite chilly with lows ranging from the upper 20s across the northwest mountains to the 30s elsewhere.
