OPEN:

FLOODING – Clearfield County, 6/2/16 – A Flash Flood Warning was in effect for Clearfield County until 2345 on 6/2/2016. Parts of the county received over four inches of

rain in a short period of time resulting in multiple road closures and heavy local flooding. Twenty residents were assisted in moving to a shelter at Trinity Church in the Town of Clearfield. These residents were later placed in motels by the Red Cross. A shelter remains open at Station #6, Hyde Fire Company; the Red Cross and Salvation Army are set up there. Clearfield County has issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County. The County EMA Director and County EMA Staff are still conducting damage assessments.

ROAD CLOSURE – Montgomery County – 6/2/16 - U.S. 422 Eastbound is closed between the Stowe exit on and off ramps in West Pottsgrove Township. The West End Fire Company Fire Police are on scene and JD Eckman Construction has been notified due to reports the roadway is buckling.

DISASTER DECLARATIONS:

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.

The President's action makes federal funding available to Commonwealth and local governments and certain private nonprofit organizations on a cost-sharing basis for emergency work and the repair or replacement of facilities damaged by the severe winter storm in Adams, Bedford, Berks, Blair, Bucks, Chester, Cumberland, Dauphin, Fayette, Franklin, Fulton, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh, Montgomery, Northampton, Perry, Philadelphia, Schuylkill, Somerset, Westmoreland, and York counties.

National Weather Service, 0542 hours, 06/03/16:

Showers and thunderstorms will continue to move across Pennsylvania today with lingering showers and thunderstorms continuing through the morning and early afternoon. The showers and storms will gradually shift to southeastern Pennsylvania this afternoon with skies becoming partly sunny elsewhere. High temperatures will range from the low 70s in the Poconos to the low 80s in the Susquehanna Valley.
