**POWER OUTAGES – Southeastern Pennsylvania, 6/8/16** – A storm system with thunderstorms, rain, hail, and high winds knocked out power for customers in Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties. At the peak of the storm, approximately 62,000 customers were without power. PECO activated its Emergency Operations Center. Throughout the day contractors and PECO restoration teams worked to restore service. As of 6/10/16, approximately 515 customers in southeastern Pennsylvania are still without power.

#### **DISASTER DECLARATIONS:**

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.

#### **24-hour Projected Weather Statewide:**

##### **National Weather Service, 0503 hours, 06/10/16:**

High pressure will bring mostly sunny and seasonable conditions to Pennsylvania today with low humidity and high temperatures in the 70s. An approaching warm front will spread scattered showers and thunderstorms into the western half of the state late tonight, while fair weather continues in the east. Lows tonight will range from the upper 40s over the Pocono Mountains, to the mid 60s around Pittsburgh.

The warm front will push into the region on Saturday, accompanied by scattered showers and thunderstorms. A few of the thunderstorms Saturday afternoon could contain strong wind gusts and hail. Highs Saturday will be mostly in the 80s and will be accompanied by much higher humidity.

A cold front will sweep through early Sunday, followed by mostly sunny and breezy conditions the rest of the day.
