NATURAL GAS LEAK – Northampton County, 6/11/16 - An odor of propane was reported in the main building of the Chandler Estates on 1569 Teels Road in Plainfield Township, Northampton County. The gas was shut off to the building and 39 residents have been evacuated and transported to the Slate Belt Baptist Church. The source of the leak is a propane tank and fire command reports negative readings in the building. Amerigas and the heating vendor ICS are checking the system for leaks. Once the all clear is given by both companies, the residents may return to the facility. Fire command has advised they could be on scene for an extended amount of time.

MISSING PERSON – Northampton County, 6/11/16 - A search was being conducted for a suicidal male who went missing from the 300 block of Old Allentown Road in Bushkill Township. He may be armed with a gun and has past suicide attempts and psychological issues. Moore Township Police, Slate Belt Regional and fire and EMS resources were assisting with the search. A PA State Police helicopter was also requested. The search was suspended and assisting agencies were recalled. Unknown when the search will resume.

CLOSED:

POWER OUTAGES – Southeastern Pennsylvania, 6/8/16 – A storm system with thunderstorms, rain, hail, and high winds knocked out power for customers in Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties. At the peak of the storm, approximately 62,000 customers were without power. PECO activated its Emergency Operations Center. Throughout the day contractors and PECO restoration teams worked to restore service. As of 6/10/16, at 0730 hours most customers had their power restored.

GAS LINE STRUCK – Northampton County, 6/10/16 - Easton Public Works reported they struck a gas line at 1438 Lehigh Street in Easton City. There were no injuries, but the 1400 block of Lehigh Street was closed and evacuated until UGI could turn off the gas. 34 residents were moved to the end of the block. Residents were allowed to return to their homes a little over a hour later.

FIRE ALARM – Dauphin County, 6/10/16 – Units responded to a fire alarm at the PEMA building, 2605 Interstate Drive, Susquehanna Township. The alarm was set off when an elevator motor was being serviced and released a small amount of smoke into the building. There was no fire. The fire department inspected the motor, determined that there was no issue, and cleared the scene.

MISSING PERSON – Bradford County, 6/11/16 – An active search took place for a missing 87 year old man who took a walk from his home located on Mercur Hill Road in Wysox Township. The man was found three and half hours later and was transported to Towanda Memorial Hospital for exposure.

DISASTER DECLARATIONS:

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.

24-hour Projected Weather Statewide:

National Weather Service, 0545 hours, 06/11/16:

A warm front will push through central and eastern Pennsylvania this morning, accompanied by a shower in spots. By afternoon, there is the chance of some stronger thunderstorms forming in the building heat and humidity. Under partly sunny skies, highs this afternoon will range from the low 80s across the northern mountains, to near 90 in the southern valleys.

Scattered evening thunderstorms will diminish tonight. It will be a very warm and muggy night with lows near 70 over the central and southern counties. The arrival of a cold front will bring cooler conditions to the northern tier by dawn Sunday.

Mostly sunny and breezy conditions are expected Sunday, as the cold front passes south of the state and cooler, drier air works in on a northwest flow. Highs Sunday will range from the upper 60s across the northwest mountains, to the low 80s over the southeast Piedmont.
