CLOSED:

THREE ALARM FIRE – Philadelphia County, 6/12/16 - A three alarm fire occurred at the Netherlands Apartments located on Chestnut Street in the City of Philadelphia. SEPTA requested two buses to 44th and Chestnut Street for approximately 100 displaced residents. The School District of Philadelphia and American Red Cross established a reception center at the Penn Alexander School at 4209 Spruce Street. The Salvation Army also provided assistance. After 1600 Sunday the reception center was closed and residents were allowed to return to their apartments.

DISASTER DECLARATIONS:

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.
