**AIRCRAFT CRASH – Centre County, 06/16/16** - A Piper Navajo Aircraft crashed into a wooded area approximately one mile east of the University Park Airport (UNV) in Benner Township. It is a private plane that crashed with two souls on board, there were no survivors. The flight was inbound to UNV and originated in Washington County. The Civil Air Patrol has taken over security of the site from PSP. The Centre County EMA, FAA, and NTSB are on scene and will be conducting their investigation on 6/17/16.

**CLOSED:**

**POWER OUTAGE/PARTIAL EOC ACTIVATION – Bradford County, 6/16/16** - A large area of Bradford County experienced a power outage impacting 6,450 customers. The outage was caused by a fault in a circuit at a substation due to routine maintenance. The county conducted a partial activation of their EOC to Level 2. The 911 Center and EOC were on alternate power for short period. All repairs have been made.

**DISASTER DECLARATIONS:**

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.
