CLOSED:

ROAD CLOSURE – Blair County, 06/18/16 - A fatal motorcycle accident closed Interstate 99 southbound at mile marker 24 in Blair Township. There was one fatality. Traffic was rerouted to the Duncansville crossover then back onto Interstate 99 southbound.

MISSING PERSON – Chester County, 06/17/16 - A search was conducted for an 86 year old male with dementia and cardiac disease who wandered away from his residence on the 200 block of Steeplechase Drive in West Whiteland Township. Police with K9 units, fire personnel and a Philadelphia Police helicopter assisted in the search. The male was located in good health.

DISASTER DECLARATIONS:

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.
