**WATER MAIN BREAK – Dauphin County, 6/27/16** - Pinnacle Health-Harrisburg Hospital is on total divert due to a water shortage/outage. The Harrisburg Hospital and the Harrisburg City Water Authority have started repairs of the water main. The repairs began at 2000 hours Monday night. This is only affecting the emergency department. During this time, the hospital will be on bottled water use.

**LANDSLIDE – Allegheny County, 6/28/16** - West Carson Street is closed between Commerce Street to the West End Circle in the City of Pittsburgh. Two large boulders have been removed from the roadway. The street will remain closed due to possible instability of the hillside. A Norfolk Southern main rail line is shut down for freight trains. No passenger trains travel this route. There are four freight trains that are being held up. They are estimating clean-up to be completed around noon today. Some freight trains will be rerouted while others will wait for the track to reopen.

#### **CLOSED:**

**ROAD CLOSURE – Berks County, 6/27/16** - A tractor trailer accident occurred on Interstate 78 westbound in Kutztown Borough. Interstate 78 westbound was closed at Exit 45 in Lehigh County. Westbound lanes were closed for almost four hours for accident clean-up.

#### **DISASTER DECLARATIONS:**

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.

##### **National Weather Service, 0400 hours, 06/28/16:**

While skies were mainly clear across northern and western Pennsylvania overnight, clouds were across the southeast. There were a few showers across eastern areas early on.

A secondary cold front over the central Great Lakes early this morning will move to just the east of the Keystone State by Wednesday morning.

Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms will be possible today and some could linger into this evening. Highs will range from the lower to mid-70s across the north and west, to the lower to mid-80s across the southeast. Lows tonight will range from the lower to mid-50s across the northern and western areas, to the upper 50s across the southeast. Highs
