SIGNIFICANT EVENTS:

OPEN:

LANDSLIDE – Allegheny County, 6/28/16 - West Carson Street is closed between Commerce Street to the West End Circle in the City of Pittsburgh. Two large boulders have been removed from the roadway. The street will remain closed due to possible instability of the hillside. A Norfolk Southern main rail line is shut down for freight trains. No passenger trains travel this route. Clean-up efforts are still in progress. The road is not expected to reopen until July 6, 2016 at the earliest.

DISASTER DECLARATIONS:

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.

West Virginia: The WV Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management is at Partial Activation (Level II) for adverse weather and flooding.

24-hour Projected Weather Statewide:

National Weather Service, 0556 hours, 07/02/16:

High pressure will build across Pennsylvania today and Sunday, supplying mostly sunny skies and low humidity. Highs today will range from around 70 degrees over the Laurel Highlands, to the low 80s across the southeast Piedmont. Lows tonight will be mostly in the 50s and highs Sunday should range from 75 to 80 over most of the state.

Low pressure tracking south of Pennsylvania will likely bring rain to the southern part of the state on the Fourth of July, while the northern tier is likely to remain dry. Highs Monday are expected to range from around 70 over the Laurel Highlands, to the low 80s across eastern Pennsylvania.


