WATER RESCUE – Wayne County, 7/4/16 – A search was conducted for a 35-year-old male who was swimming next to a boat in the Paradise Point area of Lake Wallenpaupack in Paupack Township. The male went under the water and did not resurface. The search was suspended for the night and reconvened on Tuesday, July 5th. The male's body was recovered on Tuesday morning.

DISASTER DECLARATIONS:

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.

24-hour Projected Weather Statewide:

National Weather Service, 0400 hours, 07/06/16:

Clear skies were across the Keystone state overnight. Patchy fog was across the region. Early morning temperatures ranged from the mid to upper 50s across northern Pennsylvania, 60s across most of the state, to the lower 70s across the southeast.

Temperatures will quickly warm into the 80s by early this afternoon as high pressure remains across the region. There could be shower or storm activity late today or early Thursday, but most areas will remain dry. Lows tonight will be mainly in the 60s, but in the lower 70s across the southeast part of the state.

High temperatures on Thursday will range from the 80s across most of the Keystone state to the lower 90s across the southeast.

More in the way of widespread showers and storms will be possible late in the week as a cold front moves across the area.

WATCHES AND WARNINGS:

An Excessive Heat Warning is in effect until 1800 on Friday July 8th for the following counties: Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia.
