MISSING PERSON - Northampton County, 7/8/16 - The Bethlehem Township police department conducted a search for a male who had been missing from his residence in Bethlehem Township since 7/2/16. He was not reported missing to police until 7/5/16. The male was located and is getting treatment at a hospital in New Jersey.

6/2/2016 - The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.

24-hour Projected Weather Statewide:

National Weather Service, 0558 hours, 07/09/16:

Any lingering showers will continue to weaken and dissipate as the remnants move along the northern border of Pennsylvania. Today will see skies become partly sunny. There is a lingering chance for a shower and thunderstorm this afternoon as a cold front gradually moves eastward. Humidity will begin to come down with high temperatures ranging from the mid-70s in the northwest mountains to near 90 degrees across southeastern Pennsylvania. Lows tonight will vary from the upper 50s in the north to the upper 60s through southern Pennsylvania.

Drier air will continue to filter into the region tomorrow with partly to mostly sunny skies and highs ranging from the low to mid-70s in far northeastern Pennsylvania to the mid-80s across the southeastern Piedmont.
