SEVERE WEATHER – Allegheny County, 7/15/16 – Multiple incidents of downed trees, road closures, flooding, downed utility lines, and power outages occurred throughout the county as a result of heavy rain and wind.

CLOSED:

ROAD CLOSURE - Dauphin County, 7/15/16 - Interstate 83 northbound was closed for approximately 10 hours at exit 44B (19th Street) in Harrisburg City due to an overturned tractor-trailer. The truck was hauling frozen chickens and a PA Department of Agriculture food inspector was called to the scene.

DISASTER DECLARATIONS:

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.

24-hour Projected Weather Statewide:


National Weather Service, 0527 hours, 07/16/16:
