ROAD CLOSURE - Washington County, 7/16/16 – Interstate 70 westbound in Fallowfield Township, between exits 36 and 35, was closed for nearly four hours due to a fatal accident. A pedestrian working on a disabled vehicle was struck by a passing tractor trailer. PennDOT set up a detour and assisted the State Police with removing approximately 50 vehicles in the trapped queue.

WATER LEAK IN HIGH RISE – Allegheny County, 7/16/16 – A water leaked forced the displacement of thirty residents of the Harrison High Rise on Broadview Boulevard in Harrison Township. The eight story apartment building houses primarily elderly residents.

DISASTER DECLARATIONS:

6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.
