6/2/2016 – The Commissioners of Clearfield County have issued Declarations of Disaster Emergencies for Lawrence Township, Clearfield Borough, and Clearfield County due to severe weather and flooding.

**24-hour Projected Weather Statewide:**

**National Weather Service, 0533 hours, 07/18/16:**

Showers and thunderstorms over the northwest early this morning will break up a bit, but will continue to make rain as they move across the state through the morning. Skies may clear for a few hours before a cold front drops down from the north. Additional thunderstorms will form and drop southward this afternoon and evening. Some of these storms will be severe, producing strong wind gusts. Expect high temperatures to get into the lower 80s in the Alleghenies and into the lower to mid-90s in the southeastern cities.

The thunderstorms will slide to the south of the state tonight along with the cold front. Skies will clear up over the north tonight, while mostly cloudy skies remain in the south. Lows will dip into the mid-50s in the north central mountains, but will be up in the mid-70s in Philadelphia.

Tuesday should be a refreshing day with much lower humidity, especially across the north. Temperatures will be about 5 degrees cooler than today topping out in the mid-70s to mid-80s.
