**MANDATORY WATER RESTRICTIONS – Cameron County, 8/2/16** – Driftwood Borough instituted water restrictions due to lack of rain and low flow conditions at their Nanny Run Reservoir. The water levels are now maintaining, with tank and reservoir levels at full. The Borough lifted the water restriction.

**STRUCTURE FIRE – Berks County, 8/22/16** – A fatal two alarm structure fire occurred at 3996 Penn Avenue (Route 422) in Sinking Spring Borough. The roadway was closed for an extended period of time for fire fighting operations.

**ROAD CLOSURE – York County, 8/22/16** – A fatal motorcycle accident closed US Route 30 eastbound from Roosevelt Avenue to Fairlane Road in York City. The roadway was closed an extended period of time for a police investigation.

**DISASTER DECLARATIONS:**

8/17/16 – The Borough Council Members of Donora Borough issued a Declaration of Disaster for the borough, due to severe weather.

8/10/2016 – The Borough Council Members of Albion Borough issued a Declaration of Disaster Emergency for the borough, due to a drought/water emergency.

7/25/2016 – The Mayor of Dunmore Borough issued a Declaration of Disaster Emergency for the borough, due to severe weather.

7/19/2016 – The U.S. Small Business Administration issued a SBA disaster declaration for Fayette, Greene, Somerset, Washington and Westmoreland counties for damages during the flooding event on June 17, 2016. The effective date is 7/19/16 and termination date for applications is 9/19/16. Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) application termination date is 4/19/17.

3/23/16 - The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to supplement commonwealth and local recovery efforts in the area affected by the severe winter storm which occurred January 22-23, 2016. The designation is FEMA-4267-DR.

The weather pattern will turn warmer and more humid through mid to late week, with the greatest potential for thunderstorms from Thursday into Friday. Fair and dry weather is


