PROCLAMATION

*Proclamation
Terminating the State of Disaster Emergency*

May 10, 2012

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2012, I proclaimed the existence of a disaster emergency in the Commonwealth due to winter storm conditions that had the potential to cause significant adverse impacts; and

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2012 and April 24, 2012, the winter storm impacted the northern and western regions of the Commonwealth with heavy snow accumulation and power outages; and

WHEREAS, ongoing monitoring of conditions and investigations made at my direction have disclosed that the adverse impacts of the winter storm have been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist and the dangers posed by this winter storm have passed.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 7301(c) of the Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa. C.S. Section 7101 et seq.), I do hereby proclaim the termination of the state of disaster emergency in the Commonwealth.
