Proclamation

***Terminating the State of Disaster Emergency
January 15, 2013***

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2012, I proclaimed the existence of a disaster emergency in the Commonwealth due to the threat posed by Hurricane Sandy; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane Sandy impacted the Commonwealth and caused significant adverse impacts throughout the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, recovery operations from Hurricane Sandy continue and ongoing monitoring of conditions and investigations made at my direction have disclosed that the adverse impacts of Hurricane Sandy have been dealt with to the extent that emergency conditions no longer exist.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 7301(c) of the Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa. C.S. Section 7101 et seq.), I do hereby proclaim the termination of the state of disaster emergency in the Commonwealth.
