## What type of entities/organizations are eligible to apply under NSGP?

Eligible organizations are registered 501(c)(3) nonprofits or otherwise are organizations as described under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC) and tax-exempt under section 501(a) of the IRC. The list below is not exhaustive and only provides examples of potential eligible organizations, all of which **must** be nonprofits.
